With illusionary aspects and novel design elements, this playfully contemporary design adapts to the sloping terrain by placing two separate volumes at different levels on the landscape.

A flat, gravel-covered roof and spirited facade with leaf-shaped perforations make interesting references to the natural environment, while refined floating staircases, inside and out, give the home an übermodern, otherworldly ambiance.







